



Parents Review

1. **Start** the meeting - introduce yourself and your child (bring a picture of your child).
2. **Thank** everyone for coming to your child's meeting.
3. **Review** the year and identify some highlights and celebrations.
Thank everyone who worked with your child throughout the year and if possible say their name and thank them specifically for their contributions.
 - a. *Example: We appreciate all the physical therapy strategies Mrs. Smith shared with us at home*
4. **Review** your goals and dreams for your child. Share their successes and their gifts and strengths. Share positive and possible futures.
5. **Explain** your expectations about the next year. *Example: Sally will be fully included (80% or more of her day) at her home school in her Kindergarten class with supports and services. Parents will be an integral part of her education plan.)*
6. **Share** your concerns and questions.
 - a. *Example: Communication seems to be challenging and I would like to find some ways we can communicate effectively next year so we can support our child at home?*
7. **Thank** everyone and proceed with the meeting.

(Handouts are very helpful and help families keep on track with their thoughts.)
